of me Benjamin Marsh of Middle Barton in

I appoint John Cox of Banbury in the County of
Oxford Police Sergeant and Thomas Bennett of Deddington
in the County of Oxford Solicitor hereinafter called my
Trustees to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will
I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin the bed
bedding furniture and other the contents of my bedroom
I give and bequeath to my son Sharwood All my
jewellery in and about my shop and dwellinghouse whether
new or in use I give and bequeath unto my son
Francis John the furniture and other the contents of my
living room I give and bequeath to my son Charles
my Masons ~~and~~ carpenters and other tools and also the
bed bedding furniture and other the contents of the
bedroom occupied by him I give and bequeath to
my daughter Amelia Fanny my harmonium and the
bed bedding furniture and other the contents of the
bedroom occupied by her I give devise and bequeath
All my cottages or tenements gardens hereditaments and
premises situate at Middle Barton aforesaid And all
other my real estate (if any) And also all my
Stock-in-trade household goods furniture plate Linen china
books book debts money and securities for money and all
other my personal estate and effects not hereinbefore
specifically bequeathed whatsoever and wheresoever unto my
said Trustees Upon Trust that my Trustees shall sell
call in and convert into money the same or such part
thereof as shall not consist of money and shall with
and out of the moneys produced by such sale calling
in and conversion and with and out of my ready moneys

pay my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts
and shall stand possessed of the residue thereof
In trust for my said five children in equal shares
to whom I give and bequeath the same accordingly
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
this ninth day of June One thousand eight hundred
and eighty eight.
