Will of Edward Righton of Middle Barton Yeoman 21 January 1726

To my loving son Joseph Righton messuage and 4 yard lands in Middle Barton and all other lands and tenements such as are freehold to him and his heirs for ever and such as are leasehold to him and his executors on condition to pay to my loving daughter Sarah the two several legacies hereinafter mentioned

To said loving daughter Sarah £300 to be paid to her within one month after my decease and further sum of £300 to be paid to her within one year after the decease of Joane my now wife to be paid by my son Joseph

To sd daughter Sarah all goods and furniture in the parlour and in the Chamber over it and in the Chamber where she usually lyeth and also six pair of my best Sheets my best table cloath one dozen of my best Napkins my six best pewter dishes and pewter bason and one dozen of my best plates and my pair of brass andirons in the hall and my Largest brass Kettle

My loving Wife Joane shall have the use of all my Goods and furniture in the Chamber where I now usually Lye and alsoe of four pair of Sheets one table cloath one dozen of Napkins two hand towels two Little barrells my second best brass Kettle two pewter dishes six pewter plates the metle pottagepott and Such Other of my Goods and Chattles as She Shall have Occasion for and desire not Exceeding the Value of Forty Shillings and from and after the decease of my Said Wife the Said Goods Chattells and furniture to said two Children Joseph and Sarah to be equally divided between them Share and Share alike

All the rest and residue of my Goods Chattells and personal Effects to my loving Son Joseph who is made Executor
