Died of wounds 22<sup>nd</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> May 1940 Aged 29

He is buried at the Wormhoudt Communal Cemetery, France. Row F, Grave 26.

William was a son of Charles and Edith Boffin who lived in Worton Road.

## **Gunner (Dvr 1/C) FREDERICK JOHN SHIRLEY**

942908 The Royal Artillery, 115 Field Regiment.

Died 28<sup>th</sup> May – 2<sup>nd</sup> June 1940 Aged 21

He has no known grave but is commemorated by name on the Dunkirk Memorial, France. Column 15

Frederick was a son of Frederick and Florence Ruth Shirley who lived in North Street.
